

For Firefox:

1. Open Firefox.
2. Click Tools. The Tools menu will appear.
3. On the Tools menu, click Options. The Options dialog will open.
4. On the Options dialog, click on Content.
5. Check the box next to Enable Javascript.
6. Click OK to save your changes and close the Options dialog.
7. On the Firefox toolbar, click Reload.

For Internet Explorer:

1. Open Internet Explorer.
2. Click Tools. The Tools menu will appear.
3. On the Tools menu, click Internet Options. The Internet Options dialog will open.
4. On the Internet Options dialog, click the Security tab.
5. Near the bottom click Custom Level. The Security Settings dialog will open.
6. Scroll to the Scripting group.
7. Under the Active Scripting group, select Enable. The selected item shows a black dot in the circle.
8. Click OK to save your changes and close the Security Settings dialog.
9. Click OK on the Internet Options dialog. The dialog closes.
10. On the Internet Explorer toolbar, click Refresh.
